



Attempting to define the mysterious qualities that produce fine wines are a challenge. With so many factors and differing opinions to draw from, France has provided us with the best possible definition to date: *Terroir*. The concept of *Terroir*, or sense of place, is alluded to prominently on French wine labels. Regions like Bordeaux and Burgundy rarely mention the varietals used in their wines, and focus instead on the appellations, or areas where the grapes specifically grow. *Terroir* is the belief system that takes into account the complete natural environment, such as soil, climate, and topography, that produces a particular wine. In short, the voice of the soil below speaks to us through the grapes grown above it.

With this in mind, the first part of our menu is presented based on *Terroirs*. White, red, sparkling, and rosé wines are grouped together and listed under each wine growing region. The second half of our menu lists these same offerings in a traditional fashion by wine style.

CHAMPAGNE

These are exciting times for Champagne. The dialogue, which used to center around a house style, has shifted towards a producer's ability to create a Terroir-driven wine. Thanks in large part to the current grower champagne movement, more attention has been paid to the land, as evidenced by the rise in organic and biodynamic viticulture. The bubbles have never been livelier, nor the finished blends so harmonious.

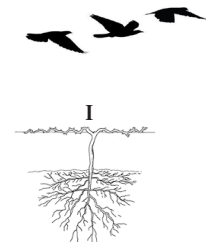

ALSACE

Alsace, with its Germanic influence, is somewhat of an oddity within France's AOC classification system. The appellation rules are not applied in the same way. These are visible in both the listing of the grape varieties on the labels, and in the shape of the bottle itself. Despite being one of France's smallest wine regions, it boasts over 13 major soil types. Alsatian winemakers primarily grow white varieties in order to best showcase the diverse range of terroir, making Alsace the only region in France that produces more white wine than red.

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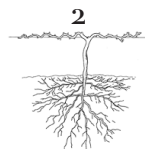

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When we opened Little Bird Bistro, we set out to create a house wine. We drew our inspiration from Alsace, specifically the Edelzwicker white wine blends, a fresh style using the region's local varieties. We turned to Brian and Jill O'Donnell of Belle Pente Vineyards who grow a number of similar Alsatian varieties used in Edelzwicker wine. What we discovered was that the wines we make each year, not only taste great young, but age fabulously.



LOIRE VALLEY

As you might expect from a region that crosses nearly all of France, there are 69 appellations in the Loire. While this may sound like a daunting region to digest, its grape varieties and styles are the best storytellers. The crisp lean wines of Muscadet are perhaps the ultimate oyster wine, while the range of Chenin Blanc, primarily grown between Anjou and Touraine, is reflected in its diverse style of wines. Sauvignon Blanc resides in the Centre Loire with various expressions, none more famed than Sancerre.

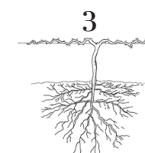

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LOIRE VALLEY

Mainly used as a blending varietal in Bordeaux, Cabernet Franc is given greater importance between the Anjou-Saumur and Touraine. It can range from pleasantly quaffable to complex, and cerebral with fresh acidity that persists despite long term aging. While Cab Franc tells an important part of the story, there are some compelling Gamay and Pinot Noir wines produced, along with some indigenous red varietals grown exclusively in the Loire.

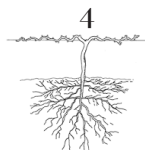

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BURGUNDY

Burgundy is the birthplace of Chardonnay. While it is one of the most widely planted grapes worldwide, you need to look no further than within the region itself to experience its wide range of expressions. The leaner, acid tension of Chablis wines in the north, seem worlds apart from the richer full-bodied styles found in the southern Mâcon. This versatility speaks to both the grape's popularity and its ability to translate terroir.

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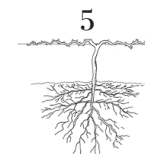

Here you will find wines of elegance, power and delicacy, but above all, purity. Red Burgundy wines have a vibration all their own.

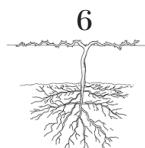

BEAUJOLAIS

This southernmost sub-region of Burgundy shares very little in common with its world renowned northern neighbors. While Burgundy is rich in diverse types of limestone, Beaujolais is characterized by its granite and volcanic influenced soil types. The highly aromatic Gamay takes center stage here, producing wines with a distinct mineral quality, best showcased among the 10 Cru Beaujolais vineyards.

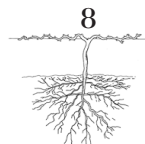

Although Oregon Pinot has been earning international accolades since the mid-70's, the current focus on farming practices, single vineyard bottlings and the spirit of our talented winemakers, all contribute in making this the golden age for Oregon wine.

NORTHERN RHÔNE

The division of the Rhône Valley is reflected not only geographically, but also in the preferred grape varieties, and quantity of wine produced. The smaller Northern half is home to the famed Côte-Rôtie and Hermitage appellations, which produce some of the finest examples of Syrah. Primarily known as a red wine region, the delicate, golden wines made from Marsanne, Roussanne, and Viognier should not be overlooked.

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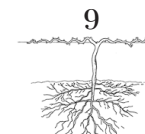

While Syrah is the star of the show in the north, it could be argued that texture is given center stage in the south. Grenache serves as the base varietal, and is usually blended with various amounts of red, and sometimes white grapes to produce a complete, fuller bodied style. Naturally, we find the influence of both Catalan and Rhône varietal blends in most of the wines produced. Despite it being such a vast territory, there's a uniquely warm Mediterranean undertone that rings throughout its wines.

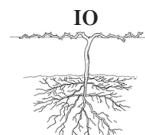

PROVENCE & CORSICA

Situated along the eastern end of the Rhône and continuing towards the Italian border, Provence provides us with a cooler interpretation of Mediterranean wine. Best known for its rosé wine, the whites and reds are quietly among the best wines produced in southern France. Provence is the closest French mainland area to the island of Corsica. Given its historical Italian presence, its wines speak to us from a truly unique point of view.

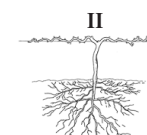

JURA & SAVOIE

The Swiss Alps cast a large shadow on these 2 regions along its western border. Jura's white wines are best known for its purposely oxidized qualities and draw many comparisons to Spanish sherry. The fruity, pale, light bodied reds made from the local Ploussard and Trousseau grapes have a distinctly light hearted character not found elsewhere in France. Often overlooked, the wines of Savoie are finally beginning to have their moment. The local white varietals, Jacquère, Altesse, and Gringet reveal sophisticated acidity, and express an unmistakable alpine character.

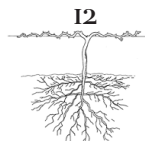

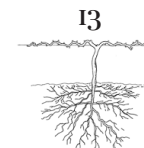

SUD-OUEST

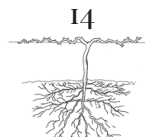
Overshadowed by its Bordeaux neighbor to the north, this sun drenched region and its full bodied offerings are perfect for finding warmth during winter. Argentina may be largely responsible for making Malbec a household name, but Cahors is the first place it called home. Malbec, aka Côt, is the most recognizable grape in an area filled with many other obscure varietals. You may also find labels written in Basque in some areas, due to the region's close proximity to Spain.
